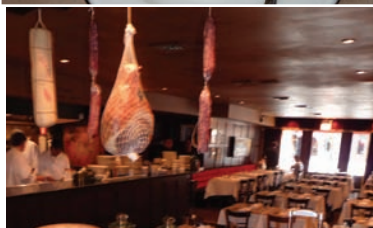


Gioco, 1312 S. Wabash, Chicago
